Additional information and some helpful reminders:

In Year 1, P.E. lessons are every **Tuesday** for two hours (one hour with Miss Saxby and one hour with Mr Whitfield, with a 20 minutes break in between). This term, the P.E focus will be multiskills! The children will change for P.E. in school so they must bring their full P.E. kit to school every Monday morning. It is important that every item in your child's P.E. kit is clearly labelled. Your child will bring their P.E kit home on a Friday for you to wash ready for the next



Uniform

It is also important to label **every** item of your child's uniform (tie and blazer included). As we are now in the Autumn term, children need to arrive at school wearing the correct Autumn term uniform which can be found in the uniform policy. This includes a jumper or a blazer, **white** shirt with the correct colour tie (according to their school house) and **black** trousers or skirt. Please note, this does not include the summer dresses. Black school **tights** or **socks are to be** worn under dresses and skirts only and not leggings. It is your child's responsibility to look after their belongings.

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Reading

Similarly to reception, we will continue to follow the Little Wandle phonics scheme. It is extremely important that you read with your child at home, every night, for at least **ten minutes**. Starting next week, your child will come home with a personal reading journal. Please record your reading with them - even a simple signature to acknowledge the reading is fine. Every day, your child will have their Little Wandle reading session; please remember to bring their books into school every single day. To prevent the loss of many books and the consequential disruption of the program, we as a team have put a system in place: if any book is not returned on three occasions, you will receive an online log in to access a digital library instead of having a paper book.

Absence

A reminder that when your child is unwell or unable to attend school, you must email: <u>attendance@livingstone-aspirations.org</u> Please state your child's name, class teacher and reason for absence.

Bookbags

Your child does not need to bring in a rucksack and should only bring in their book bag containing their reading books or reading journal. They will also need to bring their P.E. kit in on a **Monday** in their drawstring bag and their water bottle and lunchbox daily (if they have packed lunch). There is not enough room for large rucksacks on their classroom pegs.
