


PROUD

<u>Attendance</u>

It can be difficult to know whether your child is too ill to attend school. NHS<u>guidance</u> is clear that it's fine to send them in with a minor cough or common cold, provided they don't have a temperature. If in doubt please encourage your child to attend, we can look after medication for them if they have ailments such as period pains, headaches and in the event that your child becomes unwell while at school, we have a careful monitoring system in place and will not hesitate to contact you and arrange for them to be sent home.







Punctuality

We are starting to see an increasing number of students arriving late to the Academy. Please ensure you are encouraging your child to develop healthy morning routines to ensure they are in school on time. Our gates open at 8.15am and all students need to be in lessons for 8.30am start.

<u>Uniform</u>

As we are coming to the end of this half term, we would like to remind you about our <u>uniform expectations</u> for the upcoming term and kindly request that you ensure your child has the necessary uniform items in time for their return to school after the half-term break.

ParentLine confidential text messaging service

ParentLine is a confidential text messaging service providing parents and carers of 0-5 year olds in Dorset to seek advice from our health visiting team about their child's health and development via text message.

Parents and carers can seek advice about a range of issues such as breastfeeding, bottle feeding, weaning, sleep, toileting, minor illness, behaviour, parenting and more.

ParentLine runs 9am-5pm, Monday to Friday (excluding weekends and bank holidays) with a ParentLine practitioner responding to messages within one working day. If a text is sent outside these hours the parent/carer will receive an automated message with advice on where to get help if they require it urgently. This new messaging service is being provided in addition to the current health visiting service offer.
